- 2 relating to the sunset review of certain river authorities.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 222, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 § 222.001. CREATION. (a) A conservation and reclamation district
- 7 to be known as the "Lower Colorado River Authority" is created. The
- 8 authority is a governmental agency and a body politic and
- 9 corporate.
- 10 (b) The authority is created under and is essential to
- 11 accomplish the purposes of Section 59, Article XVI, Texas
- 12 Constitution, including the control, storing, preservation, and
- 13 distribution of the waters of the Colorado River and its
- 14 tributaries within the boundaries of the authority for irrigation,
- 15 generation of electric energy and power, and other useful purposes;
- 16 the reclamation and irrigation of arid, semiarid, and other lands
- 17 needing irrigation; the development of parks on lands owned or
- 18 acquired by the authority; and the conservation and development of
- 19 the forests, water, and electric power in this state.
- 20 (c) Nothing in this chapter or in any other law shall be
- 21 construed as authorizing the authority to levy or collect taxes or
- 22 to create any indebtedness payable out of taxes or in any way to
- 23 pledge the credit of this state.
- 24 (d) The authority is a state agency subject to review for

- 1 the purposes of Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act),
- 2 <u>but may not be abolished under that Act. The review shall be</u>
- 3 conducted as if the authority were scheduled to be abolished
- 4 <u>September 1, 2009.</u>
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
