5	SECTION 1. Section 1131.802, Insurance Code, is amended to

8	AND CHILDREN; ELIGIBLE CHILDREN. Insurance under a group life
9	insurance policy may be extended to cover:

11	insured under the policy; [ <del>or</del> ]
12	(2) a natural or adopted child of each individual
13	eligible to be insured under the policy if the child is:
14	(A) <u>unmarried and</u> younger than $25$ [ $21$ ] years of

16	(B) [older than 21 years of age and:
17	[ <del>(i) enrolled as a full-time student at an</del>
18	educational institution; or
19	[ <del>(ii)</del> ] physically or mentally disabled and
20	under the parents' supervision; or
21	(3) a natural or adopted grandchild of each individual

- 1 (C) a dependent of the insured for federal income
- 2 tax purposes at the time the application for coverage of the child
- 3 <u>is made</u>.
- 4 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 5 to a group life insurance policy delivered, issued for delivery, or
- 6 renewed on or after January 1, 2008. A policy delivered, issued for
- 7 delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2008, is governed by the law
- 8 in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and
- 9 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
