A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to emission reduction strategies for greenhouse gases.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 382, Health and Safety
5	Code, is amended by adding Section 382.0174 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 382.0174. EMISSION REDUCTION STRATEGIES FOR
7	GREENHOUSE GASES. (a) In this section, "greenhouse gas" includes
8	carbon dioxide, methane, nitrous oxide, hydrofluorocarbons,
9	perfluorocarbons, and sulfur hexafluoride.
10	(b) Not later than December 31, 2008, the commission shall
11	prepare and deliver to each member of the legislature a report
12	including a list of strategies for reducing emissions of greenhouse
13	gases in this state that:
14	(1) may result in net savings for consumers or
15	businesses in this state; or
16	(2) can be achieved without financial cost to
17	consumers or businesses in this state.
18	(c) In preparing the list of emission reduction strategies,
19	the commission shall consider the strategies for reducing the
20	emissions of greenhouse gases that have been implemented in other
21	states or nations.
22	(d) In determining under Subsection (b) whether an emission
23	reduction strategy may result in a financial cost to consumers or
24	businesses in this state, the commission shall consider the total

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- 1 net costs that may occur over the life of the strategy, as opposed
- 2 to the short-term capital costs that may result from the
- 3 <u>implementation of the strategy.</u>
- 4 (e) The commission may appoint advisory committees to
- 5 assist the commission in identifying and evaluating greenhouse gas
- 6 <u>emission reduction strategies.</u>
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
