5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 401.301, Health and Safety Code, is

7 amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:

- 8 (f) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section,
- 9 the department may not assess a fee on a local law enforcement

10 agency for the licensing and registration of an X-ray machine that

- is used to screen packages or other objects the agency suspects may
- 12 contain an explosive or other item that would pose a danger to the
- 13 public health and safety. Except as otherwise provided by this
- 14 <u>subsection</u>, a local law enforcement agency is subject to the
- 15 licensing and registration requirements of this chapter.
- 16 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act to Section
- 17 401.301, Health and Safety Code, apply to the licensing and
- 18 registration of an X-ray machine on or after the effective date of
- 19 this Act. The licensing and registration of an X-ray machine before
- 20 the effective date of this Act is covered by the law in effect
- 21 immediately before that date, and the former law is continued in
- 22 effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
