- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 708.153, Transportation
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) A rule under this section:
- 8 (1) may not permit a person to pay a surcharge over a
- 9 period of more than 36 consecutive months; and
- 10 (2) may provide that if the person fails to make a
- 11 required installment payment, the department may reestablish the
- 12 installment plan or declare the amount of the unpaid surcharge
- immediately due and payable.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 708.155, Transportation Code, is amended
- 15 to read as follows:
- 16 Sec. 708.155. CONTRACTS FOR COLLECTION OF SURCHARGES.
- 17 (a) The department may enter into a contract with a private
- 18 attorney or a public or private vendor for the provision of services
- 19 for the collection of surcharges receivable and related costs under
- this chapter.
- 21 (b) To provide for alternative or additional collection
- 22 methods for surcharges receivable, the department may amend a
- 23 contract entered into under Subsection (a) and enter into
- 24 additional contracts under Subsection (a).

- 1 (c) The total amount of compensation under a contract
- 2 <u>entered into under this section</u> may not exceed 30 percent of the
- 3 amount of the surcharges and related costs collected.
- 4 SECTION 3. Subchapter D, Chapter 708, Transportation Code,
- is amended by adding Section 708.157 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 708.157. AMNESTY AND INCENTIVES. (a) The department
- 7 by rule may establish a periodic amnesty program for holders of a
- 8 driver's license on which a surcharge has been assessed for certain
- 9 offenses, as determined by the department.
- 10 (b) The department by rule may offer a holder of a driver's
- 11 license on which a surcharge has been assessed an incentive for
- 12 compliance with the law and efforts at rehabilitation, including a
- 13 reduction of a surcharge or a decrease in the length of an
- 14 installment plan.
- 15 (c) The department by rule may establish an indigency
- 16 program for holders of a driver's license on which a surcharge has
- 17 been assessed for certain offenses, as determined by the
- department.
- 19 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act to Section
- 20 708.155, Transportation Code, do not affect the entitlement of a
- 21 private attorney or a public or private vendor with whom the
- 22 Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas contracts under
- that section immediately before September 1, 2007, to bid on the
- 24 additional contract.
- 25 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
