S.B. No. 1727

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to requiring the Department of Family and Protective
3 Services to provide certain information to a foster child who
4 leaves foster care.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 264, Family Code, is
7 amended by adding Section 264.014 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 264.014. PROVISION OF COPIES OF CERTAIN RECORDS. The
9 department shall provide to a child, not later than the 30th day
10 after the date the child turns 18 years old or is discharged from
11 foster care, whichever date occurs first, a copy of:

12 (1) the child's birth certificate;

13 (2) the child's immunization records; and

14 (3) the information contained in the child's health
15 passport, if permitted under Section 266.006.

16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
