## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the satisfaction of a condition of community

3 supervision requiring performance of community service.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 16, Article 42.12, Code of Criminal

Procedure, is amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:

- 7 (f) A judge may permit a defendant to substitute for
- 8 community service otherwise required by this section a one-time
- 9 payment to the community supervision and corrections department
- 10 supervising the defendant, a charitable organization, or a drug
- 11 <u>court.</u> For each amount contributed under this subsection that
- 12 equals the amount of the federal minimum wage, the defendant is
- 13 <u>entitled to one hour's credit against required community service</u>
- 14 hours.

- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 16 defendant placed on community supervision before, on, or after the
- 17 effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
