SECTION 3. Subsection (d), Section 754.015, Health and 8 9 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows: 10 (d) The executive director may charge a reasonable fee as 11 set by the commission for: 12 (1)registering or renewing registration of an 13 inspector; (2) 14 registering or renewing registration of а 15 contractor; 16 (3) applying for a certificate of compliance; 17 (4) filing an inspection report as required by Section 754.019(a)(3), 30 days or more after the date the report is due, for 18 each day the report remains not filed after the date the report is 19 20 due; (5) applying for a waiver, variance, or delay; and 21 22 (6) attending a continuing education program sponsored by the department for registered QEI-1 inspectors. 23 SECTION 4. Subdivision (11), Section 754.011, Health and 24 25 Safety Code, is repealed. SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 27
