- 5 SECTION 4. Proof of publication of the constitutional
- 6 notice required to introduce this Act under Subsection (d), Section
- 7 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, has been furnished as provided
- 8 by that subsection. A copy of the notice and the Act as originally
- 9 introduced have been delivered to the governor as required by
- 10 Subsection (d), Section 59 of that article. The legislature finds
- 11 and declares that the notice and the delivery are proper and
- 12 sufficient to satisfy the constitutional requirements.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
