BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 28.002, Education Code, is amended by 1-13 1**-**14 1**-**15 adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:

(q) The essential knowledge and skills for health courses 1-16 include, at appropriate grade levels, knowledge and skills must related to personal safety and to recognizing and reporting 1-17 inappropriate conduct by an adult towards a student, including 1-18 inappropriate verbal comments, physical contact, photography, and online communications. In identifying essential knowledge and skills under this subsection, the State Board of Education shall 1-19 1-20 1-21 1-22 consult the Texas School Safety Center in addition to the 1-23

participants described by Subsection (c). SECTION 2. Not later than March 1, 2008, the State Board of Education, in consultation with the Texas School Safety Center, 1-24 1-25 shall identify the knowledge and skills related to personal safety 1-26 1-27 to include among the essential knowledge and skills required for health courses, as provided by Subsection (q), Section 28.002, Education Code, as added by this Act. 1-32 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
