(c) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor. 1-24 1-25 1-26 1-27 (d) It is a defense to prosecution under Subsection (a)(1)1-28 the person to whom the salvia divinorum was sold or given the defendant apparently 1-29 presented to valid proof identification. 1-30 1-31 (e) A proof of identification satisfies the requirements of 1-32 Subsection (d) if it contains a physical description and photograph consistent with the person's appearance, purports to establish that 1-33 the person is 18 years of age or older, and was issued by a governmental agency. The proof of identification may include a driver's license issued by this state or another state, a passport, 1-34 1-35 а 1-36 or an identification card issued by a state or the federal 1-37 government. 1-38

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
