7	Sec. 25.00231. BOND; INSURANCE. (a) This section controls
8	over a specific provision for a particular court or county that
9	attempts to create a requirement for a bond or insurance that
10	conflicts with this section.
11	(b) Before beginning the duties of office, a judge of a
12	statutory probate court must execute a bond that is:
13	(1) payable to the county treasurer;
14	(2) in the amount of \$500,000;
15	(3) conditioned on the faithful performance of the
16	duties of the office; and
17	(4) approved by the commissioners court.

- 18 <u>(c) In lieu of the bond required by Subsection (b), a county</u>
  19 <u>may elect to obtain insurance in the amount required by Subsection</u>
  20 <u>(b) against losses caused by the statutory probate court judge's</u>
  21 gross negligence in performing the duties of office.
- 22 <u>(d) The commissioners court of a county shall pay the</u>
  23 <u>premium for the bond or insurance required by this section out of</u>
  24 the general funds of the county.

- 3 SECTION 3. A judge of a statutory probate court who is
- 4 serving on the effective date of this Act shall comply with the
- 5 requirements of Section 25.00231, Government Code, as added by this
- 6 Act, not later than November 1, 2007.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect October 1, 2007.
