  district must obtain the written consent of a parent of the student.
  A request for written consent under this subsection:
- 16 (1) may not be included with any other notification or request for written consent provided to the parent; and
- 18 (2) must be provided to the parent not later than the
  19 14th day before the date on which the human sexuality instruction
  20 begins.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2007-2008 22 school year.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
