AN ACT

2	relating to NAFTA priority projects of the Texas Department of
3	Transportation; providing for the issuance of revenue bonds.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 201, Transportation Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter P to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER P. NAFTA PRIORITY PROJECTS; BORDER
8	INFRASTRUCTURE FUND
9	Sec. 201.981. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
10	(1) "Commercial motor vehicle" has the meaning
11	assigned by 49 C.F.R. Section 390.5.
12	(2) "Fund" means the border infrastructure fund.
13	(3) "NAFTA priority project" means a transportation
14	project undertaken by the department that is designed to:
15	(A) facilitate the flow of commercial motor
16	vehicle traffic in international commerce and provide direct access
17	to one or more international ports of entry;
18	(B) carry a heavier volume of commercial motor
19	vehicles carrying freight in international commerce than domestic
20	commerce and be used primarily in support of just-in-time
21	manufacturing operations; and
22	(C) relieve the burden on local streets and
23	highways caused by commercial motor vehicles engaged in
24	<u>international commerce.</u>

- 1 Sec. 201.982. BORDER INFRASTRUCTURE FUND. (a) The border
- 2 infrastructure fund is a dedicated account in the state treasury.
- 3 (b) The proceeds of tolls imposed under this subchapter
- 4 shall be deposited in the fund.
- 5 (c) Money in the fund may be used only to pay principal of,
- 6 interest on, and expenses related to bonds issued under this
- 7 <u>subchapter.</u>
- 8 (d) The commission shall administer the fund.
- 9 Sec. 201.983. REVENUE BONDS. (a) The commission may issue
- 10 revenue bonds and use the proceeds only to fund NAFTA priority
- 11 projects.
- 12 (b) The bonds do not constitute a debt of the state or a
- 13 pledge of the faith and credit of the state, but may be repaid only
- 14 from the proceeds of tolls imposed under this subchapter.
- (c) All laws generally applicable to revenue bonds issued by
- 16 the state apply to bonds issued under this subchapter.
- 17 Sec. 201.984. IMPOSITION OF TOLL. (a) The commission shall
- impose a toll on each commercial motor vehicle leaving the state at
- 19 the international border.
- 20 (b) The department shall use electronic toll collection
- 21 technology to collect a toll under this subchapter and may use any
- other method to collect or enforce a toll under this subchapter that
- 23 the department is authorized to use in connection with a state
- 24 highway toll project under Chapter 228.
- Sec. 201.985. RULES. The commission shall adopt rules to
- 26 implement this subchapter.
- 27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
