- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 815, Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 815.402. COLLECTION OF MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS.
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Section 813.201, each payroll period,
- 9 each department or agency of the state shall cause to be deducted
- 10 from each member's compensation a contribution of:
- 11 (1) six six and four-tenths percent of the
- 12 compensation if the member is not a member of the legislature; or
- 13 (2) eight percent of the compensation if the member is
- 15 (b) To facilitate the making of deductions, the board of
- 16 trustees may modify a member's required deductions by an amount
- 17 that does not exceed one-tenth of one percent of the annual
- 18 compensation on which the deduction is made.

- 19 (c) Each department or agency head shall certify to the
- 20 board of trustees and to the disbursing officer of the department or
- 21 agency on each payroll, or in another manner prescribed by the
- board, the amounts to be deducted from each member's compensation.
- 23 (d) The disbursing officer of each department or agency on
- 24 authority from the department or agency head shall:

- 1 (1) make deductions from each member's compensation
- 2 for contributions to the retirement system;
- 3 (2) transmit monthly, or at the time designated by the
- 4 board of trustees, a certified copy of the payroll or report to the
- 5 retirement system; and
- 6 (3) pay the amount deducted to the retirement system
- 7 for deposit in the employees saving account.
- 8 (e) The retirement system shall record all receipts of
- 9 member contributions and shall deliver the receipts to the
- 10 comptroller. The comptroller shall credit the receipts to the
- 11 employees saving account.
- 12 (f) The deductions required by this section shall be made
- even if the member's compensation is reduced below the amount equal
- 14 to the minimum compensation provided by law.
- 15 (g) By becoming a member of the retirement system, a member
- 16 consents to the deductions required by this section. The payment of
- 17 compensation less those deductions is a complete release of all
- 18 claims, except benefits provided by this subtitle, for services
- 19 rendered by the member during the payment period.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
