- 13 working paper is also maintained in another record, that other
- 14 record is not excepted from the requirements of Section 552.021 by

- SECTION 2. Subdivision (1), Subsection (b), Section
- 17 552.116, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 18 (1) "Audit" means an audit authorized or required by a
- 19 statute of this state or the United States, the charter or an
- 20 ordinance of a municipality, an order of the commissioners court of
- 21 a county, <u>a resolution or other action of a board of trustees of a</u>
- 22 <u>school district</u>, or a resolution or other action of a joint board
- 23 described by Subsection (a) and includes an investigation.

- 1 audit working paper created before, on, or after the effective date
- 2 of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
