## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a pilot project regarding funding for professional
3	nursing education programs offered by general academic teaching
4	institutions and health-related institutions.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 61.0592 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 61.0592. PILOT PROJECT REGARDING FUNDING FOR
9	PROFESSIONAL NURSING EDUCATION PROGRAMS. (a) The board shall
10	develop and implement a pilot project in which the board, with
11	respect to appropriations recommendations for the 2010-2011 state
12	fiscal biennium for the professional nursing education programs
13	that are offered by general academic teaching institutions that
14	elect to participate in the project, uses:
15	(1) funding formulas, other than mission-specific
16	funding formulas, that to the extent practicable are based solely
17	on elements that are the same as the elements of the general and
18	supplemental funding formulas used to make appropriations
19	recommendations for professional nursing programs offered by
20	health-related institutions; and
21	(2) percentages for dividing money among the
22	professional nursing education program formulas applicable to a
23	general academic teaching institution that to the extent

practicable are the same as the percentages for dividing money

- 1 among the formulas for professional nursing education programs
- 2 offered by health-related institutions.
- 3 (b) For purposes of Subsection (a)(1), elements of funding
- 4 formulas are comparable if they contain the same weights, models,
- 5 scales, or rates, as applicable.
- 6 (c) The board shall require a general academic teaching
- 7 <u>institution that elects to participate in the pilot project to:</u>
- 8 (1) maintain a clinical faculty-to-student ratio in
- 9 the institution's professional nursing education program of not
- more than 13 to 1, if the applicable faculty member will be the only
- 11 person officially responsible for the clinical group; and
- 12 (2) not later than December 1, 2012, submit a report to
- 13 the board regarding:
- 14 (A) any effects of the funding and
- 15 faculty-to-student ratios provided under the pilot project on the
- 16 <u>institution's professional nursing education programs, including</u>
- 17 the number of:
- (i) students admitted to or graduating from
- 19 the programs; and
- 20 (ii) faculty, clinical preceptors, or
- 21 clinical teaching assistants in the education programs; and
- (B) any other related information the board
- 23 considers appropriate.
- 24 (d) Any increase in a clinical faculty-to-student ratio in
- 25 accordance with this section is not a ground for withdrawal of the
- 26 approval of a professional nursing education program.
- (e) This section expires December 31, 2012.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
