3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 361, Health and Safety
5	Code, is amended by adding Section 361.0881 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 361.0881. PERMIT REVIEW. (a) The commission shall
7	review a permit issued under this chapter every five years if:
8	(1) the facility has a compliance history that is in
9	the lowest classification under Sections 5.753 and 5.754, Water
10	Code, and rules and procedures developed under those sections; or
11	(2) the review is requested by:
12	(A) a state legislator representing the area in
13	which the facility is located;
14	(B) a local governmental entity with
15	jurisdiction over the location of the facility, by resolution of
16	the entity's governing body;
17	(C) a council of governments with jurisdiction
18	over the area of the facility, by formal request of either the
19	council's solid waste advisory committee, executive committee, or
20	governing board;
21	(D) a homeowners' or property owners' association
22	formally organized or chartered and having at least 10 members
23	located in the general area in which the facility is located; or
24	(E) 10 or more local residents, property owners,

1	or businesses located in the general area in which the facility is
2	<pre>located.</pre>
3	(b) The commission by rule shall establish a review
4	<pre>procedure that includes:</pre>
5	(1) notice of the review and the opportunity for
6	<pre>public comment:</pre>
7	(A) on the commission's Internet website; and
8	(B) mailed to each person entitled to receive
9	notice of a permit application;
10	(2) commission staff response to comments as required
11	for permit applications and modifications;
12	(3) a review of all complaints regarding the facility
13	received in the preceding five years, including a determination of:
14	(A) the number of complaints;
15	(B) the number of people lodging complaints; and
16	(C) the commission's evaluation of those
17	<pre>complaints;</pre>
18	(4) consultation with the commission enforcement
19	staff in the regional office responsible for overseeing the
20	facility; and
21	(5) review of all instances of alleged noncompliance,
22	including instances that do not result in a written notice of
23	violation.
24	(c) The commission may:
25	(1) recommend changes to a permit reviewed under this
26	section; or
27	(2) impose a limit on the term of a facility's permit

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- 1 <u>if a review under this section reveals that a facility may threaten</u>
- 2 <u>the public health or safety or the environment.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 361.088(g), Health and Safety Code, is
- 4 repealed.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
