5	SECTION 1. Section 841.146(c), Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(c) <u>The</u> [In an amount not to exceed \$2,500, the] State of
8	Texas shall pay all <u>reasonable</u> costs <u>of</u> :
9	<u>(1)</u> [associated with] a civil commitment proceeding
10	conducted under Subchapter D <u>;</u>
11	(2) [. The State of Texas shall pay the reasonable
12	costs of] state or appointed counsel or experts for <u>a</u> [any other]
13	civil commitment proceeding conducted under <u>Subchapter F or G; and</u>
14	(3) [this chapter and shall pay the reasonable costs
15	of] the person's outpatient treatment and supervision.
16	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
17	to an individual who on or after September 1, 2007, is serving a
18	sentence in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice or is
19	committed to the Department of State Health Services or the
20	Department of Aging and Disability Services for an offense
21	committed before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.
22	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
