1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the establishment of a student outcomes pilot program
1-9 at Alamo Community College.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 130, Education Code, is
1-12 amended by adding Section 130.0105 to read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 130.0105. ESTABLISHMENT OF STUDENT OUTCOMES PILOT
1-14 PROGRAM AT ALAMO COMMUNITY COLLEGE. (a) Alamo Community College
1-15 shall establish a pilot program to collect and analyze statistical
1-16 data regarding student outcomes at the college in order to:

1-17 (1) facilitate accountability at the college by
1-18 determining the efficacy of instruction at the college and
1-19 examining the transition of students to four-year institutions of
1-20 higher education; and

1-21 (2) further ongoing education excellence initiatives
1-22 at the college.

1-23 (b) This section expires September 1, 2017.

1-24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-28 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
