4	SECTION 1. Section 21.052, Education Code, is amended by
5	adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:
6	(c) The board may issue a temporary certificate under this
7	section to an educator who holds a degree required by Subsection
8	(a)(1) and a certificate or other credential required by Subsection
9	(a)(2) but who has not satisfied the requirements prescribed by
10	Subsection (a)(3). Subject to Subsection (d), the board may
11	specify the term of a temporary certificate issued under this
12	subsection.
13	(d) A temporary certificate issued under Subsection (c) to
14	an educator employed by a school district that has constructed or
15	expanded at least one instructional facility as a result of
16	increased student enrollment due to actions taken under the Defense
17	Base Closure and Realignment Act of 1990 (10 U.S.C. Section 2687)
18	may not expire before the first anniversary of the date on which the
19	board completes the review of the educator's credentials and
20	informs the educator of the examination or examinations under
21	Section 21.048 on which the educator must perform successfully to
22	receive a standard certificate.
23	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
