

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the creation of the Hardin Store Road Municipal Utility  
3 District No. 1 of Montgomery County; providing authority to impose  
4 a tax and issue bonds; granting the power of eminent domain.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 6, Special District Local Laws  
7 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 8245 to read as follows:

8 CHAPTER 8245. HARDIN STORE ROAD MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT

9 NO. 1 OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY

10 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

11 Sec. 8245.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

12 (1) "Board" means the board of directors of the  
13 district.

14 (2) "Director" means a member of the board.

15 (3) "District" means the Hardin Store Road Municipal  
16 Utility District No. 1 of Montgomery County.

17 Sec. 8245.002. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a  
18 municipal utility district in Montgomery County created under and  
19 essential to accomplish the purposes of Section 59, Article XVI,  
20 Texas Constitution.

21 Sec. 8245.003. CONFIRMATION ELECTION REQUIRED. If the  
22 creation of the district is not confirmed at a confirmation  
23 election held under Section 8245.024 before September 1, 2011:

24 (1) the district is dissolved September 1, 2011,

1 except that:

2 (A) any debts incurred shall be paid;

3 (B) any assets that remain after the payment of  
4 debts shall be transferred to Montgomery County; and

5 (C) the organization of the district shall be  
6 maintained until all debts are paid and remaining assets are  
7 transferred; and

8 (2) this chapter expires September 1, 2014.

9 Sec. 8245.004. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The  
10 district is initially composed of the territory described by  
11 Section 2 of the Act creating this chapter.

12 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of  
13 the Act creating this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the  
14 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process  
15 does not affect:

16 (1) the organization, existence, or validity of the  
17 district;

18 (2) the right of the district to impose taxes;

19 (3) the validity of the district's bonds, notes, or  
20 indebtedness; or

21 (4) the legality or operation of the district or the  
22 board.

24 SUBCHAPTER A-1. TEMPORARY PROVISIONS

25 Sec. 8245.021. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) On or after  
26 September 1, 2007, a person who owns land in the district may submit  
27 a petition to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality

1 requesting that the commission appoint as temporary directors the  
2 five persons named in the petition.

3 (b) The commission shall appoint as temporary directors the  
4 five persons named in the first petition received by the commission  
5 under Subsection (a).

6 (c) If a temporary director fails to qualify for office, the  
7 commission shall appoint a person to fill the vacancy.

8 (d) Temporary directors serve until the earlier of:

9 (1) the date directors are elected under Section  
10 8245.024; or

11 (2) the date this chapter expires under Section  
12 8245.003.

13 Sec. 8245.022. ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING OF TEMPORARY  
14 DIRECTORS. As soon as practicable after all the temporary  
15 directors have qualified under Section 49.055, Water Code, the  
16 temporary directors shall meet at a location in the district  
17 agreeable to a majority of the directors. At the meeting, the  
18 temporary directors shall elect officers from among the temporary  
19 directors and conduct any other district business.

20 Sec. 8245.023. CONSENT OF MUNICIPALITY REQUIRED. The  
21 temporary directors may not hold an election under Section 8245.024  
22 until each municipality in whose corporate limits or  
23 extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located has adopted a  
24 resolution consenting to the creation of the district.

25 Sec. 8245.024. CONFIRMATION AND INITIAL DIRECTORS'  
26 ELECTION. The temporary directors shall hold an election to  
27 confirm the creation of the district and to elect five directors as

1 provided by Section 49.102, Water Code.

2 Sec. 8245.025. INITIAL ELECTED DIRECTORS; TERMS. The  
3 directors elected under Section 8245.024 shall draw lots to  
4 determine which two shall serve until the first regularly scheduled  
5 election of directors under Section 8245.052 and which three shall  
6 serve until the second regularly scheduled election of directors.

7 Sec. 8245.026. EXPIRATION OF SUBCHAPTER. This subchapter  
8 expires September 1, 2014.

9 [Sections 8245.027-8245.050 reserved for expansion]

10 SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

11 Sec. 8245.051. DIRECTORS; TERMS. (a) The district is  
12 governed by a board of five directors.

13 (b) Directors serve staggered four-year terms.

14 Sec. 8245.052. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS. On the uniform  
15 election date in May of each even-numbered year, the appropriate  
16 number of directors shall be elected.

17 [Sections 8245.053-8245.100 reserved for expansion]

18 SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES

19 Sec. 8245.101. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND  
20 DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided by the  
21 general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code,  
22 applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59,  
23 Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

24 Sec. 8245.102. ROAD PROJECTS. (a) To the extent  
25 authorized by Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the  
26 district may construct, acquire, improve, maintain, or operate  
27 macadamized, graveled, or paved roads or turnpikes, or improvements

1 in aid of those roads or turnpikes, inside the district.

2 (b) A road project must meet or exceed all applicable  
3 construction standards, zoning and subdivision requirements, and  
4 regulatory ordinances of each municipality in whose corporate  
5 limits or extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located.  
6 If the district is located outside the extraterritorial  
7 jurisdiction of a municipality, a road project must meet all  
8 applicable construction standards, zoning and subdivision  
9 requirements, and regulatory ordinances of each county in which the  
10 district is located.

11 (c) The district may not undertake a road project unless  
12 each municipality in whose corporate limits or extraterritorial  
13 jurisdiction the district is located consents by ordinance or  
14 resolution.

15 Sec. 8245.103. COMPLIANCE WITH MUNICIPAL CONSENT  
16 RESOLUTION. The district shall comply with all applicable  
17 requirements of any resolution adopted by the governing body of a  
18 municipality under Section 54.016, Water Code, that consents to the  
19 creation of the district or to the inclusion of land in the  
20 district.

21 Sec. 8245.104. RECREATIONAL FACILITIES; LIMIT ON EMINENT  
22 DOMAIN POWER. (a) In this section, "recreational facilities" and  
23 "develop and maintain" have the meanings assigned by Section  
24 49.462, Water Code.

25 (b) The district may develop and maintain recreational  
26 facilities in the manner provided by Subchapter N, Chapter 49,  
27 Water Code.

1       (c) The district may not, for the development or maintenance  
2 of a recreational facility, acquire by condemnation land, an  
3 easement, or other property inside or outside the district.

5               SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS

6       Sec. 8245.151. TAX TO REPAY BONDS. The district may impose  
7 a tax to pay the principal of or interest on bonds issued under  
8 Section 8245.201.

9       [Sections 8245.152-8245.200 reserved for expansion]

10               SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS

11       Sec. 8245.201. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER  
12 OBLIGATIONS. (a) The district may issue bonds or other  
13 obligations as provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to  
14 finance the construction, maintenance, or operation of projects  
15 under Sections 8245.101 and 8245.102.

16       (b) The district must hold an election in the manner  
17 provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to obtain voter approval  
18 before the district may issue bonds payable from ad valorem taxes.

19       (c) The district may not issue bonds to finance projects  
20 authorized by Section 8245.102 unless the issuance is approved by a  
21 vote of a two-thirds majority of the voters of the district voting  
22 at an election called for that purpose.

23       (d) Bonds or other obligations issued or incurred to finance  
24 projects authorized by Section 8245.102 may not exceed one-fourth  
25 of the assessed value of the real property in the district.

26       Sec. 8245.202. BONDS FOR RECREATIONAL FACILITIES. If  
27 authorized at an election under Section 8245.201(b), the district

1 may issue bonds payable from ad valorem taxes to pay for the  
2 development and maintenance of recreational facilities under  
3 Section 8245.104.

4 SECTION 2. The Hardin Store Road Municipal Utility District  
5 No. 1 of Montgomery County includes all the territory contained in

12 THENCE North 02 degrees 43 minutes 09 seconds West, a distance of
