| 5  | SECTION 1. Section 419.0321(e), Government Code, is amended                    |
| 6  | to read as follows:  |
| 7  | (e) A part-time fire protection employee may not:                              |
| 8  | (1) work more than 24 hours a week or average more than                        |
| 9  | approximately 24 hours a week during a work cycle, as appropriate,             |
| 10 | for an employing fire department; or   |
| 11 | (2) work <u>in duties related to fire suppression</u> more                     |
| 12 | than <u>:</u>  |
| 13 | <u>(A)</u> 500 hours a year for an employing fire                              |
| 14 | department, except as provided by Paragraph (B); or                            |
| 15 | (B) 1,000 scheduled hours a year for an employing                              |
| 16 | fire department with fewer than 5 full-time firefighters in a                  |
| 17 | municipality that assesses no city property tax [ <del>in duties related</del> |
| 18 | to fire suppression].  |
| 19 | SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 14, 2007.                           |
