- 2 relating to a program to reduce the emissions of nitrogen oxides
- 3 from certain stationary compressor engines.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (d), Section 382.051866, Health and
- 6 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) Money in the emissions reductions incentives account
- 8 may be appropriated only to pay for emissions reduction project
- 9 incentives under a program developed under Section 382.051867
- 10 [382.051865] and administrative expenses associated with providing
- 11 the incentives or the incentive program established under that
- 12 section.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 382, Health and Safety
- 14 Code, is amended by adding Section 382.051867 to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 382.051867. RICH-BURN COMPRESSOR ENGINE GRANTS.
- 16 (a) In this section, "rich-burn compressor engine" means a
- 17 spark-ignited, Otto cycle, four-stroke, naturally aspirated or
- 18 turbocharged compressor engine that is capable of being operated
- 19 with an exhaust stream oxygen concentration equal to or less than
- 20 0.5 percent by volume, as originally designed by the manufacturer.
- 21 (b) The commission by rule shall develop a grant program to
- 22 assist facilities in reducing emissions of nitrogen oxides from
- 23 <u>stationary gas-fired, rich-burn compressor engines by installing</u>
- 24 nonselective catalytic reduction systems or other

- 1 commission-approved control systems.
- 2 (c) To be eligible for a grant under the program, a person
- 3 must, by the dates provided by Subsection (d) or (e), as applicable,
- 4 install at a facility a system that limits a rich-burn compressor
- 5 engine's discharge of nitrogen oxides and have verified that the
- 6 system limits those emissions to:
- 7 (1) 1.00 grams per horsepower hour for an engine with a
- 8 rated maximum capacity of less than 500 horsepower;
- 9 (2) 0.60 grams per horsepower hour for an engine with a
- 10 rated maximum capacity of 500 horsepower or greater that is fired
- 11 with landfill gas; or
- 12 (3) 0.50 grams per horsepower hour for an engine with a
- 13 rated maximum capacity of 500 horsepower or greater that is fired
- other than with landfill gas.
- (d) Except as provided by Subsection (e), the grant program
- 16 must provide for a partial reimbursement of the capital costs of
- 17 <u>installing a system for reducing nitrogen oxides emissions at a</u>
- 18 rate of:
- 19 <u>(1) 75 percent of those costs if the installation</u>
- 20 occurs and the emissions reductions are verified after August 31,
- 21 <u>2007</u>, and before January 1, 2008; and
- (2) 50 percent of those costs if the installation
- occurs and the emissions reductions are verified after December 31,
- 24 2007, and before April 1, 2008.
- (e) This subsection applies only if the Act enacting this
- 26 <u>section takes immediate effect.</u> If the Act enacting this section
- 27 takes immediate effect, Subsection (d) has no effect. The grant

- 1 program must provide for a partial reimbursement of the capital
- 2 costs of installing a system for reducing nitrogen oxides emissions
- 3 at a rate of:
- 4 (1) 75 percent of those costs if the installation
- 5 occurs and the emissions reductions are verified after April 30,
- 6 2007, and before August 1, 2007; and
- 7 (2) 50 percent of those costs if the installation
- 8 occurs and the emissions reductions are verified after July 31,
- 9 2007, and before April 1, 2008.
- 10 (f) The commission may adopt emergency rules under Section
- 11 2001.034, Government Code, with abbreviated notice, to carry out
- 12 any rulemaking necessary to implement this section.
- 13 (g) The commission may authorize the executive director to
- 14 enter into contracts with a public agency, private person, or other
- 15 <u>entity for the purpose of implementing the emissions reduction</u>
- 16 grant program developed under this section.
- 17 (h) This section does not affect the responsibility or
- 18 liability of an owner or operator of a stationary gas-fired,
- 19 rich-burn compressor engine to reduce emissions under this chapter
- or a rule, permit, or order adopted under this chapter.
- 21 (i) The commission shall require verification of the
- 22 reductions associated with the program before the commission
- 23 distributes a grant.
- 24 (j) A grant under this section is contingent on the
- 25 availability of funds. The commission shall award grants in the
- 26 order in which applications with any required verification of
- 27 reductions are received. The commission may not pay or otherwise

- 1 provide a grant after August 31, 2008.
- 2 (k) This section expires August 31, 2008.
- 3 SECTION 3. Subsection (e), Section 382.051866, Health and
- 4 Safety Code, is repealed.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
