## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT relating to the creation of the Rolling V Ranch Water Control and 2 3 Improvement District No. 1 of Wise County; providing authority to impose a tax and issue bonds; granting the power of eminent domain. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Subtitle I, Title 6, Special District Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Chapter 9021 to read as follows: 7 CHAPTER 9021. ROLLING V RANCH WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT 8 DISTRICT NO. 1 OF WISE COUNTY 9 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS 10 Sec. 9021.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter: 11 12 (1) "Board" means the district's board of directors. 13 (2) "Director" means a board member. 14 (3) "District" means the Rolling V Ranch Water Control and Improvement District No. 1 of Wise County. 15 Sec. 9021.002. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a water 16 control and improvement district in Wise County created under and 17 18 essential to accomplish the purposes of Section 59, Article XVI, and Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution. 19 Sec. 9021.003. If the 20 21 creation of the district is not confirmed at a confirmation 22 election held under Section 9021.024 before November 4, 2009: 23 (1) the district is dissolved November 4, 2009, except 24 that the district shall:

2	(B) transfer to Wise County any assets that
3	remain after the payment of debts; and
4	(C) maintain the organization of the district
5	until all debts are paid and remaining assets are transferred; and
6	(2) this chapter expires September 1, 2014.

11	be divided into two new districts only if the district:

14	construction, maintenance, or operation of a project under Section
15	9021.101 or 9021.102.
16	(b) The district may not issue bonds or other obligations to
17	finance projects authorized by Section 9021.102 unless the issuance
18	is approved by a vote of a two-thirds majority of the district
19	voters voting at an election called for that purpose.
20	(c) Bonds or other obligations issued or incurred to finance
21	projects authorized by Section 9021.102 may not exceed one-fourth
22	of the assessed value of the real property in the district.

(a) The legal notice of the intention to 20 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this 21 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a 22 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, 23 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished 24 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, 25 Government Code.

(b) The governor, one of the required recipients, hassubmitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on

1 Environmental Quality.

2 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed 3 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the 4 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of 5 representatives within the required time.

6 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this 7 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect 8 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled 9 and accomplished.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
