- 2 (y) The El Paso Council of Judges shall order the transfer
- 3 of criminal misdemeanor cases to the <u>county criminal courts at law</u>
- 4 [County Criminal Courts No. 1 and No. 2] from time to time to
- 5 equalize the criminal misdemeanor dockets of the statutory county
- 6 courts for the efficient operation of the court system and the
- 7 effective administration of justice.
- 8 (z) The County Criminal Courts No. 1, [and] No. 2, No. 3, and
- 9 No. 4 have the criminal jurisdiction provided by law for county
- 10 courts and appellate jurisdiction in appeals of criminal cases from
- 11 justice courts and municipal courts in the county as provided by
- 12 Article 45.042, Code of Criminal Procedure.
- SECTION 3. The County Criminal Court at Law No. 3 of El Paso
- 14 County, Texas, and the County Criminal Court at Law No. 4 of El Paso
- 15 County, Texas, are created September 1, 2007.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
