- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 102.004(a), Family Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) In addition to the general standing to file suit
- 8 provided by Section 102.003, a grandparent, or another relative of
- 9 the child related within the third degree by consanguinity, may
- 10 file an original suit requesting managing conservatorship if there
- is satisfactory proof to the court that:
- 12 (1) the order requested is necessary because the
- 13 child's present circumstances would significantly impair the
- 14 child's physical health or emotional development; or
- 15 (2) both parents, the surviving parent, or the
- 16 managing conservator or custodian either filed the petition or
- 17 consented to the suit.
- 18 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 19 102.004, Family Code, applies only to an original suit affecting
- 20 the parent-child relationship filed on or after the effective date
- 21 of this Act. An original suit affecting the parent-child
- 22 relationship filed before the effective date of this Act is
- 23 governed by the law in effect on the date that the suit was filed,
- 24 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
