## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to authorizing the Texas Transportation Commission, subject to legislative review and approval, to designate an area adjacent to a state highway project as a transportation finance zone and requiring that the revenue from the state sales and use taxes imposed in a transportation finance zone be used to pay obligations issued in connection with the state highway project

- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 10 SECTION 1. Subchapter M, Chapter 201, Transportation Code, 11 is amended by adding Section 201.9435 to read as follows:
- Sec. 201.9435. TRANSPORTATION FINANCE ZONES. (a) This
  section applies only to a state highway project in connection with
  which the commission has issued or proposes to issue obligations
  under Section 201.943.
- 16 (b) The commission by order or resolution may designate as a
  17 transportation finance zone an area that is adjacent to the
  18 right-of-way of an existing or proposed state highway project and
  19 within two miles on either side of the center line of the state
  20 highway.
- 21 (c) The designation of a transportation finance zone is not
  22 effective until the legislature has reviewed and approved the
  23 designation and boundaries of the zone.
- 24 (d) Notwithstanding Section 151.801(a), Tax Code, proceeds

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- 1 from the collection of the taxes imposed by that chapter in
- 2 connection with a sale, storage, use, or other consumption that is
- 3 consummated in a transportation finance zone shall be deposited to
- 4 the credit of a separate account in the fund.
- 5 (e) The proceeds from the collection of taxes deposited to
- 6 the credit of the fund under Subsection (d) may be used only for the
- 7 purpose of paying the principal of and interest on obligations
- 8 issued in connection with the state highway project located in the
  - transportation finance zone in which the taxes were collected or a
- 10 <u>related credit agreement.</u>
- 11 (f) A transportation finance zone terminates on the earlier
- 12 of:

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- (1) the termination date, if any, specified in the
- order or resolution designating the zone; or
- 15 (2) the date on which the principal of and interest on
- the applicable obligations or related credit agreement are paid.
- 17 <u>(g) The commission and the comptroller shall adopt rules to</u>
- implement and administer this section.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2008, but only
- 20 if the constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature to
- 21 permit the Texas Transportation Commission, subject to legislative
- 22 review and approval, to designate the area adjacent to a state
- 23 highway project as a transportation finance zone and dedicating the
- 24 proceeds of the state sales and use taxes imposed in a
- 25 transportation finance zone to the Texas Mobility Fund for certain
- 26 purposes is approved by the voters. If that amendment is not
- 27 approved by the voters, this Act has no effect.
