CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the 80th Legislature, That a joint
2 committee, composed of six members of the senate appointed by the
3 lieutenant governor and six members of the house appointed by the
4 speaker of the house, arrange for the canvass of the votes cast for
5 governor and lieutenant governor at the general election held on
6 November 7, 2006, and that a joint session of the senate and house
7 be held in the hall of the house of representatives at 11 a.m.,
8 Thursday, January 11, 2007, for the purpose of counting the votes,
9 receiving the report, and hearing the declaration of the results of
10 the canvass; and, be it further

11 RESOLVED, That the senate and house sit in joint session at 10
12 a.m. on Tuesday, January 16, 2007, for the inauguration of the
13 governor-elect and lieutenant governor-elect of Texas as
14 determined by the canvass of the votes; and, be it further

15 RESOLVED, That a joint committee, composed of five members of
16 the senate appointed by the lieutenant governor and five members of
17 the house appointed by the speaker of the house, make arrangements
18 for the joint session and oath-taking ceremony on January 16, 2007;
19 and, be it further

20 RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Safety of the State
21 of Texas be, and is hereby, instructed to close all vehicle
22 entrances to the Capitol grounds on Tuesday, January 16, 2007,
23 except for those vehicles approved by the inaugural committee as
24 necessary for use in connection with the ceremony and the program
