CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, It is desirable to adopt by resolution various rules 2 and policies regarding the operation of joint committees to 3 supplement, and reconcile differences between, the senate and house 4 rules of procedure; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the 80th Legislature of the State of Texas 6 hereby confirms the proclamation of the lieutenant governor and the 7 speaker of the house of representatives creating the Joint Select 8 Committee on the Operation and Management of the Texas Youth 9 Commission; and, be it further

10 RESOLVED, That the co-chairs of the joint select committee, 11 acting jointly and within two weeks of the proclamation, prepare 12 and present to the presiding officers a proposal for budget and 13 staffing; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the co-chairs be directed to use to the greatest extent possible the existing staff and administrative resources of committee members, standing committees, officers of the senate and house, and legislative service agencies; and, be it further

19 RESOLVED, That the presiding officers of each house jointly 20 review the budget and staffing proposal, adopt budgetary and 21 staffing allocations, and determine the manner in which the joint 22 select committee is to be funded; and, be it further

23 RESOLVED, That the joint select committee co-chairs, acting
24 by mutual agreement, have authority to create and appoint

subcommittees or affiliated advisory panels and to designate respective chairs for each, contingent on the advance approval of the presiding officers for the creation and appointment of subcommittees or advisory panels containing membership external to the committee; and, be it further

6 RESOLVED, That the joint select committee, and its 7 subcommittees and advisory panels, convene at the call of the 8 respective co-chairs or chairs; provided that the committee, its 9 subcommittees, and its advisory panels may not convene in a public hearing or other meeting for the transaction of business unless 10 public notice has been posted by the respective co-chairs or chairs 11 at the locations specified by the senate and house rules of 12 procedure for posting of notice of standing committee meetings at 13 14 least 24 hours in advance of the hearing or meeting; and, be it 15 further

RESOLVED, That the preceding clause be construed, for purposes of Section 551.046, Government Code, as a joint rule of the senate and house of representatives controlling the posting of notice for the joint select committee and its subcommittees and advisory panels, in lieu of required posting with the secretary of state; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the joint select committee have authority to issue process as provided by Sections 301.024-301.027, Government Code, provided that any motion for the issuance of process must receive the record vote of at least two-thirds of the committee members present and voting, a quorum being present; and, be it further

1 RESOLVED, That the joint select committee have authority to 2 meet in executive session for the limited purpose of examining a 3 witness or deliberating, considering, or debating a decision, 4 provided that no decision may be made or voted on except in a 5 meeting that is open to the public; and, be it further

6 RESOLVED, That the joint select committee be entitled to 7 accept grants and donations as provided by Subsections (b) and (c), 8 Section 301.032, Government Code, and that, on expiration of the 9 committee, any unexpended funds remaining from a grant or donation 10 be transferred in equal proportions to the accounts of the senate 11 and house of representatives unless otherwise provided by the 12 grantor or donor; and, be it further

13 RESOLVED, That the joint select committee have all other 14 powers and duties provided to special committees by Subchapter B, 15 Chapter 301, Government Code, and the senate and house rules of 16 procedure; and, be it further

17 RESOLVED, That the operating account for the joint select 18 committee and any grants and donations that the committee may 19 receive be administered by the Texas Legislative Council; and, be 20 it further

21 RESOLVED, That the joint select committee use the February 2006 edition of the procedures manual for joint committees, which 22 establishes requirements to printing needs, 23 as accounting 24 procedures, ultimate disposition of records, and other 25 administrative and financial matters until a new edition is 26 published by the Texas Legislative Council; and, be it further 27 RESOLVED, That the Texas Legislative Council be authorized to

1 reimburse the senate and house of representatives for expenses 2 incurred by members of the senate and house for transportation, 3 meals, lodging, and incidentals for travel on official business of 4 the joint select committee; and, be it further

5 RESOLVED, That the final report of the joint select committee 6 be approved by a majority of the voting membership of the committee; 7 dissenting voting members may attach statements to the final report 8 subject to any limitations specified in the rules adopted by the 9 committee; and, be it further

10 RESOLVED, That the joint select committee expires on January 11 13, 2009.
