18 WHEREAS, Corporal Bevel was fulfilling his duties in Iraq 19 with fortitude and unwavering determination; he was a brave man and 20 a true American hero who took pride in his service on behalf of his 21 country; and

22 WHEREAS, He was a man of courage, strength, and quiet 23 determination who was known for his ready sense of humor, his deep 24 faith, and his compassion and ability to comfort others; and
