WHEREAS, He was a National Science Foundation Postdoctoral Fellow at The University of Texas at Austin from 1994 to 1996, a Visiting Scholar at Stanford University from 1996 to 1997, and a member of the Visiting Faculty at the Center for Non-Linear Studies at Los Alamos National Laboratory during the summer of 2001; and

WHEREAS, Professor Bittner has been on the faculty of the University of Houston since 1997, when he received his appointment as an assistant professor of theoretical chemistry; he was promoted to associate professor of theoretical chemistry in 2003, which is the rank he holds today; and

WHEREAS, Before becoming a John Simon Guggenheim Fellow in 2007, he received the Elizabeth A. Norris Award for Excellence in Graduate Research from The University of Chicago in 1994, the
