WHEREAS, He became a pilot with the United States Customs and Border Protection Air and Marine in 2003 and was assigned first to the Caribbean Air Branch in Puerto Rico; he transferred to McAllen in August of 2006; and

WHEREAS, Clinton was a high achiever who was noted for his
kindness and concern for others and was admired and respected by his
