1-7 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1-8 proposing a constitutional amendment providing for the
1-9 continuation of the constitutional appropriation for facilities
1-10 and other capital items at Angelo State University on a change in
1-11 the governance of the university.

1-12 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 17, Article VII, Texas
1-14 Constitution, is amended to read as follows:

1-15 (b) The funds appropriated under Subsection (a) of this
1-16 section shall be for the use of the following eligible agencies and
1-17 institutions of higher education (even though their names may be
1-18 changed):

1-19 (1) East Texas State University including East Texas
1-20 State University at Texarkana;

1-21 (2) Lamar University including Lamar University at
1-22 Orange and Lamar University at Port Arthur;

1-23 (3) Midwestern State University;

1-24 (4) University of North Texas;

1-25 (5) The University of Texas--Pan American including
1-26 The University of Texas at Brownsville;

1-27 (6) Stephen F. Austin State University;

1-28 (7) Texas College of Osteopathic Medicine;

1-29 (8) Texas State University System Administration and
1-30 the following component institutions:

1-31 (9) ~~Angelo State University;~~

1-32 ~~[(10)]~~ Sam Houston State University;

1-33 ~~[(10)]~~ ~~[(11)]~~ Southwest Texas State University;

1-54 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
1-55 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 6, 2007.
1-56 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
1-57 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing for the
1-58 continuation of the constitutional appropriation for facilities
1-59 and other capital items at Angelo State University on a change in
1-60 the governance of the university."
