WHEREAS, In honor of Lance Corporal Rodriguez's exemplary life and his sacrifice for his country, United South High School is dedicating a building for its Marine Corps Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corps in his honor on March 9, 2007; and

WHEREAS, A young man of courage, strength, and commitment, Juan was a devoted son and brother whose loyalty, compassion for others, and love of life were truly inspirational; he will long be remembered for his generous spirit and his many accomplishments; now, therefore, be it
