WHEREAS, Mrs. Sweat has three grandchildren, five great-grandchildren, and a great-great-granddaughter; her family and friends will join her on March 24, 2007, to congratulate her and celebrate her 100th birthday; the event, hosted by her daughter and son-in-law, Zora Mae and Ross Hise, will salute this important milestone in her life; now, therefore, be it
