## SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 938

WHEREAS, The Senate of the State of Texas is pleased to recognize Russell K. Tolman, president and chief executive officer of Cook Children's Health Care System, for his 25 years of exceptional leadership after joining the organization on April 2, 1982; and

WHEREAS, During his tenure, Mr. Tolman has overseen the assembly of medical talent at Cook Children's Health Care System and has watched it grow from 12 pediatric specialists to more than 220; and
