WHEREAS, When the crew of the Reveille saw the dismasting of the sailboat Paladin, they lowered their sails and motored back to rescue the sailboat, which was drifting dangerously close to the rocks of Galveston's South Jetty; and

WHEREAS, The crew members of the Reveille surrendered a commanding lead to rescue the sailors and tow the Paladin out of harm's way; and

WHEREAS, For the gallant performance of its crew members, the race committee awarded the Reveille enough points to capture first place in class and fleet; in addition, each crew member received a special award for the rescue; now, therefore, be it
