SENATE RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the State of Texas, 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, That Senate Rule 12.03 be suspended in part as provided by Senate Rule 12.08, to enable the conference committee appointed to resolve the differences on House Bill No. 2833 (the licensing and regulation of certain private security services) to consider and take action on the following matter:

Senate Rule 12.03(1) is suspended to permit the committee to change the text of SECTION 5 of the bill by substituting Paragraph (C), Subdivision (2), Subsection (c), Section 1702.113, Occupations Code, to read as follows:

(C) provides as a possible punishment  
confinement in a jail other than a state jail felony facility; or

Explanation: The change is necessary to correct a grammatical error.

Senate Rule 12.03(1) is suspended to permit the committee to change the text of SECTION 5 of the bill by substituting Paragraph (C), Subdivision (3), Subsection (c), Section

1702.113, Occupations Code, to read as follows:

(C) provides as a possible punishment
