R E S O L U T I O N

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the State of Texas, 80th
2 Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, That Senate Rule 12.03 be
3 suspended in part as provided by Senate Rule 12.08, to enable the
4 conference committee appointed to resolve the differences on House
5 Bill 2833 (the licensing and regulation of certain private security
6 services) to consider and take action on the following matter:

7 Senate Rule 12.03(1) is suspended to permit the committee to
8 change the text of SECTION 5 of the bill by substituting Paragraph
9 (C), Subdivision (2), Subsection (c), Section 1702.113,
10 Occupations Code, to read as follows:

11 (C) provides as a possible punishment
12 confinement in a jail other than a state jail felony facility; or

13 Explanation: The change is necessary to correct a
14 grammatical error.

15 Senate Rule 12.03(1) is suspended to permit the committee to
16 change the text of SECTION 5 of the bill by substituting Paragraph
17 (C), Subdivision (3), Subsection (c), Section 1702.113,
18 Occupations Code, to read as follows:

19 (C) provides as a possible punishment
20 confinement in a jail other than a state jail felony facility; or
