Suspending limitations on conference committee jurisdiction, H.B. No. 2093 (Hill/Carona)

RESOLUTION

- BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the State of Texas, 80th 1 Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, That Senate Rule 12.03 be 2 suspended in part as provided by Senate Rule 12.08 to enable the 3 conference committee appointed to resolve the differences on House 4 Bill 2093 (the issuance and enforcement of motor carrier overweight 5 or oversize vehicle permits and motor carrier registrations; 6 7 providing administrative penalties) to consider and take action on 8 the following matter:
- 9 Senate Rules 12.03(3) and (4) are suspended to permit the conference committee to add the following:
- SECTION 3. Section 622.953(b), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 13 (b) The overall gross weight of a single motor vehicle used 14 to transport seed cotton or equipment used to transport or process 15 seed cotton may not be heavier than 64,000 [59,400] pounds.
- Explanation: The change is necessary to add a provision to the bill related to weight limitations for certain vehicles transporting agricultural products and equipment.
