IN RE: HB20 by Cortez, Frank (Relating to the expulsion of students for assault of school employees.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require Disciplinary Alternative Education Program (DAEP) placement for students who commit assault to cause bodily injury against a victim other than a public school employee and for students who engage in reckless conduct that contains elements of assault against a school employee. The bill would require expulsion for students who intentionally commit assault against a school employee.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
