**IN RE: HB117** by Brown, Fred (Relating to the authority of certain counties to regulate certain subdivision planning.), **As Engrossed**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code by removing certain criteria for determining which counties may regulate certain subdivision planning. The proposed changes would expand applicability of the statute to include all counties with a population of 150,000 or more.
