IN RE: HB278 by Madden (relating to the authority of a school district board of trustees to create a criminal offense for violation of a district policy.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

The bill would limit the violations of school district policy that are punishable as a Class C misdemeanor to violations concerning the operation and parking of vehicles on school property.
