**IN RE: HB342** by Naishtat (Relating to concurrent guardianship proceedings in this state and in a foreign jurisdiction.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would provide guidelines for a court determining venue in certain guardianship proceedings, and no fiscal implication to the State is anticipated. The bill would take immediate effect if the bill receives a vote of two-thirds of the members in each House. Otherwise, the bill would take effect September 1, 2007.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
