IN RE: HB387 by Callegari (Relating to the repeal of the law relating to the Texas National Research Laboratory Commission.), **As Engrossed**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would remove statutory references to the Texas National Research Laboratory Commission, which has not functioned since 1997, and repeal laws creating the commission. It would also remove language relating to powers of eminent domain by the Higher Education Coordinating Board regarding the Super-conducting Super Collider Accelerator project.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
