IN RE: HB425 by Madden (Relating to the instructional requirements for education services provided in a juvenile residential facility operated by a juvenile board.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require the Commissioner of Education, in coordination with the Texas Juvenile Probation Commission, to determine instructional requirements for educational services provided in juvenile residential facilities.

Local Government Impact

Costs associated with implementing requirements adopted under the provisions of the bill would vary.
