IN RE: HB442 by Phillips (Relating to taking or attempting to take a Taser or similar device from a peace officer or certain other officers.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend Section 38.14(a)(2), Penal Code, to add "taser or similar device" to the defintion of "stun gun." This change would have an insignificant fiscal impact on training provided to law enforcement officers.
