IN RE: HB454 by Rodriguez (relating to a study of methods to increase public school student participation in the national school breakfast program and school district participation in a special assistance provision of the national free or reduced-price breakfast or lunch program.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The study, including the cost-benefit analysis, outline of effective programs and practices, and recommendations for increasing participation in the breakfast program, is estimated by the Texas Education Agency to be a one-time cost of \$250,000. This amount does not represent a significant cost to the agency.
