IN RE: HB684 by Pickett (Relating to state assistance for housing developments located in certain disaster areas.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code to modify certain scoring criteria to provide state assistance for housing developments located in certain disaster areas.

Based on information provided by the Department of Housing and Community Affairs, it is assumed that costs related to the duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be covered by utilizing existing resources.

This bill would take effect September 1, 2007.
